## Why the University of Bath, England?

The University of Bath offers a highly respected international university option for students seeking academic excellence, strong career outcomes, a global perspective, and a supportive pathway into life in the UK as productive global citizens.

For high-achieving students seeking a degree at a university ranked among the top 10% globally for academic excellence, Bath is much more than a study abroad experience or a sport-first opportunity. It is a serious, future-focused academic pathway connected to one of the UK's most respected universities, with the added benefit of UDA support and, for many students, the opportunity to develop in an elite, professional soccer academy environment.

## Student Profile

- Total student body of 21,000
- 152 nationalities represented
- 27% of students come from outside the UK
- Key undergraduate international markets include India, Hong Kong, France, and Spain



## Academic Profile

- 192 degree courses
- A standard three-year degree, or four years with a paid sandwich year in industry
- 92% of research defined as world-leading or internationally excellent
- A current research portfolio of £207 million across academic programs
- 43 high-tech, high-growth companies supported by Bath's SETsquared programming
- 7 start-ups and spinout companies launched by University of Bath faculty and students, generating £37 million in business and 525 jobs



## Entry Requirements

Typical entry expectations include:

- Minimum GPA of 3.5
- Three APs required
- Typically, two APs at level 5 and one at level 4
- Some AP subjects must align with the intended degree program
- Some degrees require an interview
- Some programs may require a portfolio
- IB certificate, honors, and dual credit may be accepted as equivalency
- SAT or ACT is optional



# Tuition, Scholarships, Placements, and Career Outcomes

## Tuition Costs

International tuition at the University of Bath typically ranges from:

- £24,000 to £32,000, depending on degree program

## Scholarships

Bath offers:

- Scholarships of up to £8,000 per year for international students



## Placement and Employment Outcomes

One of Bath's strongest differentiators is the connection between academics and employability.

Key outcomes include:

- 89% of students are in full-time, high-skilled employment after leaving the university
- Bath is one of the top 10 universities in the UK sought by British employers
- Completing a UK degree allows students the opportunity to apply for a post-study work extension, creating additional career pathways after graduation
- 100% of undergraduate courses offer either a placement year or study abroad option and 62% of students undertake one of these options

# A campus built for excellence

## Highlights include:

- £450 million invested across the campus in the last decade
- The £10.9 million arts and management centre, The Edge, opened in 2016
- A new School of Management building opened in 2022, including an employability hub and behavioural research lab
- Olympic-grade facilities used by elite athletes and teams
- At the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games, 17 Team Bath-associated athletes won medals

For the right student, this becomes a rare combination: a globally respected academic pathway with professional soccer academy development built into the experience.



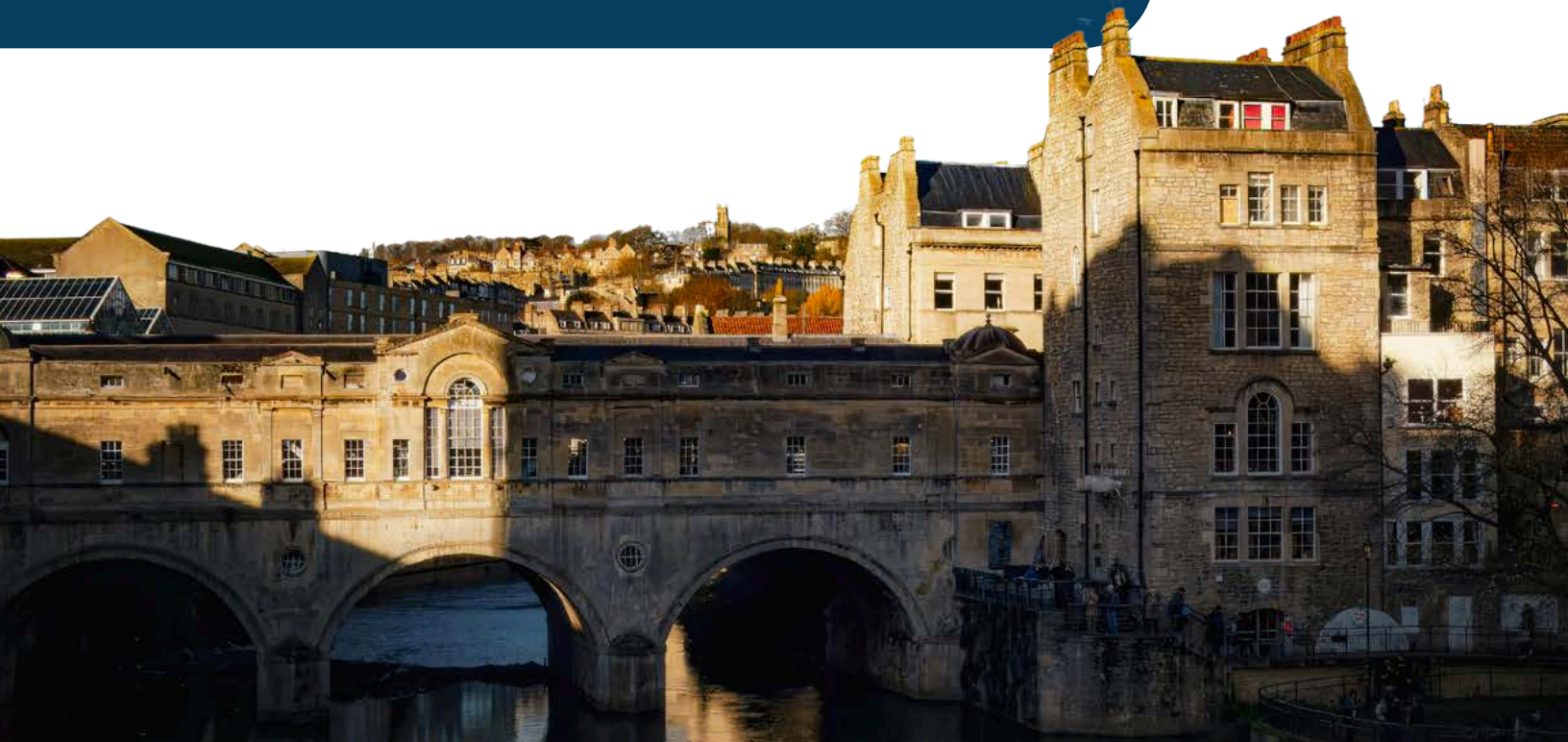
## A university with global reach

This pathway is designed for students who want:

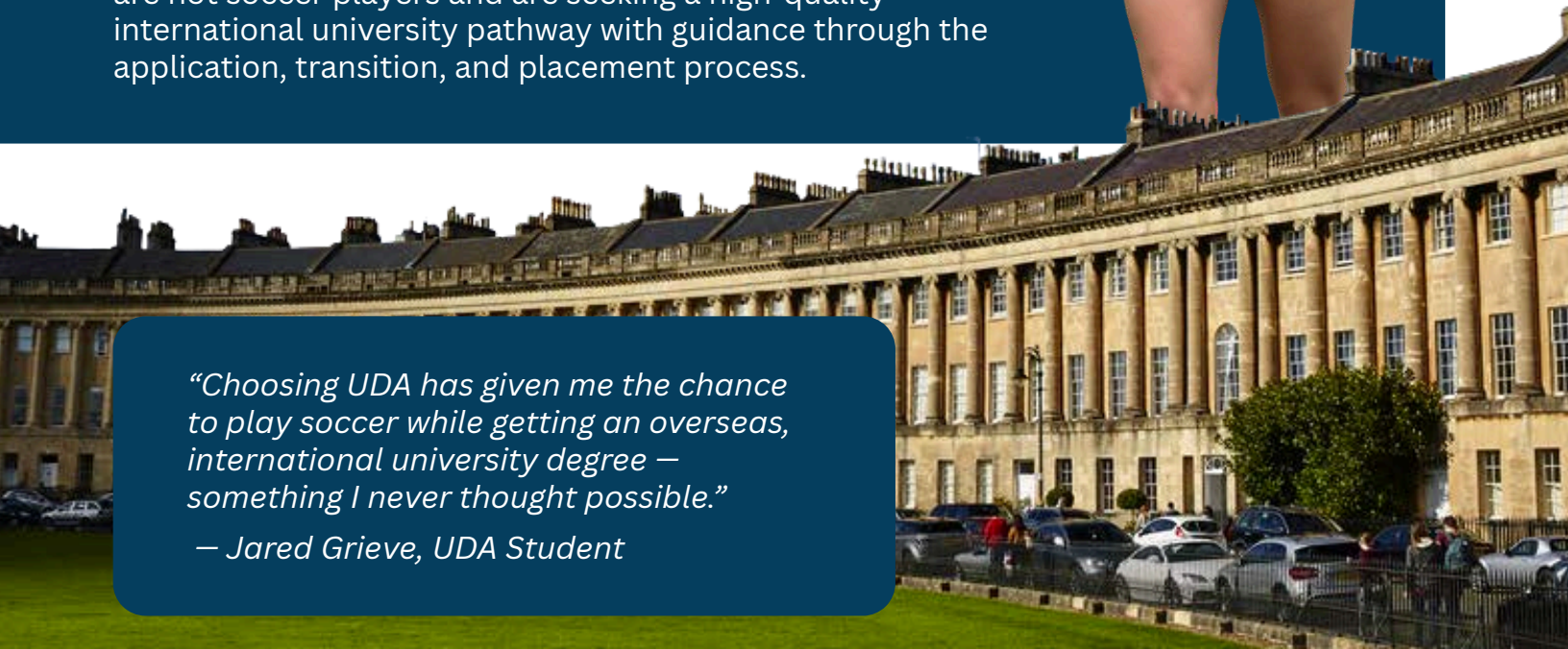
- a globally respected university degree
